3 Year Plan to improve LITERACY LEVELS

Target(s):

- To reduce the amount of pupils scoring between the 3^{rd} and 16^{th} percentile band from 3.15% to 2%
- To reduce the amount of pupils scoring between the $17^{\rm th}$ and $30^{\rm th}$ percentile band from 12.6% to 10%
- To increase the amount of pupils scoring between the $85^{\rm th}$ and $98^{\rm th}$ percentile from 24.2% to 26%
- To increase the amount of pupils scoring above the 98^{th} percentile from 1.05% to 3%
- An overall increase of 5% in Micra T scores in June 2018
- An overall increase of 5% in Drumcondra Reading scores in November 2017
